REVISED NOTICE TO THE CANDIDATES WHO HAVE APPLIED FOR MBA PROGRAMME

As scheduled CUCET results will be announced on 09.06.2017. All the applicants who have applied for MBA programme and written the Entrance Test are hereby informed to note the following instructions;

IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS

- **Eligibility criteria for MBA programme:** Bachelor's degree in any discipline from a recognized Indian or foreign university (as per the AIU foreign equivalence list) with atleast 50% marks aggregate (45% for OBC {NON CREAMY LAYER}, SC, ST, PWD and Kashmiri Migrant Students) and who have secured a minimum of 40% marks (35% for OBC (NON CREAMY LAYER) SC/ST, PWD and Kashmiri Migrant Students) in the Central Universities Common Entrance Test 2017.
- The candidates will be called for **Group Discussion and Personal Interaction in the ratio of 1:4 or more based on the merit in the entrance test.** The final merit for admission will be determined on the basis of marks obtained in the Entrance Test and Group Discussion & Personal Interaction with 50% weightage to entrance test and 50% to Group Discussion & Personal Interaction.
- The qualified candidates should be present on 05.07.2017 at 10.00 am for Group Discussion and Personal Interaction at the Dept. of Business Studies, School of Business Studies, Central University of Karnataka, Kadaganchi, Aland Road, Kalaburagi-585367
- All the original certificates of educational qualifications should be produced at the time Group Discussion & Personal Interaction.
- SC, ST, and OBC candidates should produce their Caste certificates in the GOI format (No other formats will be accepted).
- Candidates claiming reservation under HKR, PWD, Kashmiri migrants, and NSS/ NCC/ Sports quotas should produce their original certificates.
- The girl students who belong to economically weaker sections (with an annual income less than 6 lakhs) should submit the income certificate in the prescribed format issued by the competent authority.
