Prof. H.M Kasinath, Former Professor of Education, Karnataka University and Chairman of the above committee, welcomed all the members and thanked all the members for attending the meeting of Ad-hoc Board of Studies. He expressed his vision for development of School of Education in Central University.

### **Items for Ratification**

Item No. 01: Ratification of the submission of the proposal to UGC and MHRD to establish a School of Education at CUK:

The proposal submitted to UGC and MHRD has been brought to the notice of the members and it was ratified.

Item No. 02: Seeking recognition of NCTE to start the B.Ed. & M.Ed. courses from the academic year 2017-18.

The University has submitted the proposal to the NCTE for starting the School of Education in Central University on 16/01/2016 and has approved the same in the 320<sup>th</sup> meeting of SRC, NCTE, Bangalore held on 19-20 Sept 2016 to start courses with one unit of M.Ed. and one unit of B.Ed. programme with an intake of 50 students from the academic year 2017-18. The matter was placed before the BOS meeting and was approved.

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### ITEMS FOR CONSIDERATION

Item No. 03: Approval of Syllabus, Course Structure and Draft Regulations for M.Ed. & B.Ed. courses as per the NCTE Guidelines:

The BOS members discussed and finalized both the Regulations and syllabus prepared separately for B.Ed. and M.Ed. courses. These regulations are drafted keeping in view the norms and standards of the NCTE as well as the other models of the Central Universities. The proposed course structure and paper titles are based on the NCTE curriculum framework. The proposed courses are semesterized, choice based and credit based as per the National norms of the UGC. The proposed credits for both courses are on par with the other Central Universities. Care has been taken at the time of BOS meeting held on 23<sup>rd</sup> and 24<sup>th</sup> November, 2016 to prepare paperwise syllabus keeping in view the latest trends in the field of teacher and teachers training. The draft Regulations and syllabus for B.Ed. and M.Ed. courses have been approved in the BOS meeting and the same may be placed before the Academic Council for approval. Copy of the B.Ed. and M.Ed. Regulations and Syllabus has been enclosed for perusal and approval.

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The Committee resolved to recommend to the University authorities the tentative calendar of events prepared for B.Ed. and M.Ed. courses keeping in view the regular working calendar of the CUK. This is subject to modification at the time of implementation since it is provisional calendar.

The matter was discussed and approved in the BOS meeting.

Item No. 05: Admission of students for B.Ed. and M.Ed. courses through Central University Common Entrance Test (CUCET) for the academic year 2017-18.

It was resolved to select the students for B.Ed. & M.Ed. courses through Common Entrance Test conducted by the Central Universities at the National Level.

Item No. 06: Appointment of faculty member on Ad-hoc or permanent or deputation basis.

Resolved to recommend to the University concerned authorities to identify and appoint duly qualified faculty on Ad-doc basis or Permanent basis or on deputation basis for both B.Ed. and M.Ed. courses effectively from academic year 2017-18 priority.

Item No. 07: Purchase of essential Reference and Resource books on 2 years latest syllabus for B.Ed. and M.Ed. courses.

The committee resolved to recommend to the authorities to purchase the syllabus related 2 years B.Ed. and M.Ed. courses Reference and resource books worth of nearly Rs.20 lakhs immediately before starting the courses from next academic year 2017-18.

Item No. 8: Identification and allocation of adequate infrastructure and instructional facilities for proposed B.Ed. and M.Ed. courses from 2017-18 and onwards.

The committee recommended to the University authorities to allocate adequate infrastructural and instructional facilities to accommodate 50 students of B.Ed. and 50 students of M.Ed. courses along with nearly 15 faculty members on the campus before starting the courses from next academic year 2017-18.

Item No. 9: Purchase of essential Psychological and Science equipments to establish the laboratories for B.Ed. and M.Ed. courses.

The Committee resolved to recommend to the University authorities to place orders immediately with the approved agencies to supply the essential Psychological instruments and science equipments to conduct the experiments in the psychology lab and science lab worth of nearly Rs. 30 lakhs to establish the minimum labs for B.Ed. and M.Ed. students to conduct experiments envisaged in the syllabus.

Item No. 10: Inclusion of name of the newly established department "School of Education" in the university prospectus.

The Committee resolved to recommend to the University authorities to include the name of the new faculty which will come into existence from the academic year 2017-18 in the university prospectus while publishing for the ensuing academic year under the label "School of Education" with reference to both B.Ed. and M.Ed. courses with an approved intake of 50 students for each

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course.

# Item No. 11: Proposed fees structure for new B.Ed. and M.Ed. courses.

Basically both B.Ed. and M.Ed. courses are the professional courses preparing the prospective teachers and teacher educators, planners and researchers in the field of teaching and teacher education. These courses involve both theoretical and practical aspects which run throughout the academic year without any inter-semester break. Naturally it involves heavy expenditure during the entire course both on instructional and infrastructural facilities. In order to organize and run the courses more effectively and successfully at the National Level, the fees structure proposed for the course must be slightly higher than the regular fees collected for the existing courses. Taking into consideration, the BOS proposed tentatively the fees structure for B.Ed. and M.Ed. courses keeping in mind the 2 year duration for each course and 200 intake each from ensuing year. The proposed fees structure has been enclosed which has been approved by the BOS committee.

# Item No. 12: Utilization of the services of the experienced professors who have attained superannuation in the State Universities.

It has been resolved in the Ad-hoc BOS meeting to recommend to the concerned university authorities to utilize the services of professors in the State Universities superannuated at the age of 62 years but within the age of 65 years for establishment of B.Ed. and M.Ed. courses in the beginning. The teachers and research experiences as well as the administrative experience of the senior professors who have attained superannuation in the State Universities at the age of 62 years but within 65 years may be identified and invited by the University either as the age of 62 years but within 65 years may be identified and invited by the University either as Guest Faculty or Visiting faculty to establish the "School of Education" in the initial stage. Their services are most valuable and accountable in guiding the fresher and young faculty members.

# Item No. 13: Constitution of permanent BOS for the "School of Education".

It was resolved to recommend to the University authorities in the Ad-hoc BOS meeting to request the university to constitute a permanent Board of Studies for the "School of Education" after identifying / appointing the faculty members for the B.Ed. and M.Ed. courses from the academic year 2017-18 and onwards.

Item No. 14: Sending a proposal on establishing on Institute of Academic Leadership and Education Management under scheme of Pandit Madan Mohan Malaviya National Mission on Teachers and Teaching (PMMMNMTT).

It has been resolved in the BOS Ad-hoc committee meeting to send a proposal on establishing an "Institute of Academic Leadership and Education Management" under the central MHRD scheme of Pandit Madan Mohan Malaviya National Mission on Teachers and Teaching (PMMMNMTT) on the CUK campus. The proposal shall include academic and financial implications, allocation of Human Resources, duration of the programme, details about essential infrastructural facilities, library resources, guest lecturers, etc. The same resolution may be placed before the Academic Council meeting for approval.

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Lastly the BOS has directed to sumit all the approved items to place before the Academic Council of CUK for acceptance

The meeting was concluded with the thanks to all the members by the chairman of the Ad-hoc BOS committee.



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# Proceedings of the Review Committee Meeting (B.Ed.) held on 08.01.2018

The chairperson of the committee welcomed all the members of the meeting and appraised about the agenda of the meeting. The following resolutions were passed after a thorough discussion:

- 1. The committee reviewed / confirmed the academic activities of the faculties and students of the B.Ed. first semester and suggested some improvements.
- 2. The proposed time table for B.Ed. second semester was modified keeping in view the number of working days and workload of the B.Ed. Programme as per the Regulations of NCTE, 2014.
- 3. The question paper pattern of the first semester was approved and recommended the same pattern even for the second semester with minor modifications in the instructions.
- 4. The list of books to be purchased for the B.Ed. programme, as suggested by the faculty members, was approved and recommended to the university to place the orders.
- 5. Keeping in view the workload of the second semester, it was recommended to identify seven faculty members to teach and complete the academic activities of the B.Ed.
- 6. The services of the faculty members on hourly basis may be used as per the requirement shown in the time table of second semester.
- 7. Fees may be collected from the students during the admission to the B.Ed. second semester to organise the Community Living Camp (CLC) in selected villages for a period of one week. The details may be worked by the CUK Fee Committee in consultation with the Coordinator of the B.Ed. Programme.

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- 8. The committee recommended to constitute regular/ permanent Board of Studies (BOS) for Education, inviting faculties on roll from CUK / Sister Universities or other State Universities, with one or two invitees as co-opted members.
- 9. The Senior most Professor / Associate / Assistant Professor from Humanities / Social Sciences from the CUK campus may be nominated as Coordinator for Education on rotation basis.
- 10. Syllabi pertaining to POSS Hindi for First and Second semesters, and syllabi for POSS - Commerce and Accountancy for Second semester B.Ed. programme were approved for immediate implementation.

The meeting was concluded with vote of thanks by the Chairperson.



Faculty members of the Department of Education took part in the discussions.

The following points were discussed in the meeting.

- 1. The convener of BOS, Department of Education and Dean, School of Education, Central University of Karnataka extended a warm welcome to the members of BOS and expressed gratitude to the members of BOS.
- 2. The Dean gave a brief introduction of himself before asking the staff to do the same.
- 3. BOS Committee has discussed the previous meeting (3<sup>rd</sup> BOS Meeting) and ratified the minutes.
- 4. BOS committee members have discussed the nomenclature of the Department and School name in detailed and suggested to change the existing nomenclature of the School from School of Education and Training to only School of Education.
- 5. With regard to the curriculum of the department, the expert committee suggested to adopt the new National Curriculum Framework for Teacher



Education-2022(NCFTE), Which is going to be released next month and the same can be adopted for the department.

- 6. With regard to number of credits, BOS has suggested to follow the NCTE norms.
- BOS committee has discussed the examination and evaluation pattern and decided to follow the University norms in conducting examinations and evaluating marks for passing percentage.
- 8. BOS committee members strongly advocated to have MoU with the education institutions (Minimum10 Schools and Colleges) to exchange the faculty and to have knowledge sharing with the department and also to have internship for the students.
- 9. Increase the number of working days in accordance with NCTE standards.
- 10. According to NCTE standards, internship days should also be expanded.
- 11. The participants were requested to draught guidelines for internship for the department.
- 12. The convener of BOS committee gave a vote of thanks to conclude the meeting.

#### Key Points discussed:

Agenda 1. To Review and revise the syllabus of B.Ed (2 years) programme:

Revised syllabus for B.Ed (Annexure II) was presented by Dr. Suresh Anuganti. After a thorough discussion following modifications were suggested by the experts:

- a. Language of the introduction part of B.Ed Programme and its courses should be modified. Also, suggested to refer NCF Mandate document and consider the same.
- b. Each course Learning Outcomes should be mentioned very specific.
- c. Course codes are to be mentioned for each paper as per the university guidelines.
- d. Internal and external assessment ratio was decided as 40:60.
- Patterns of evaluation for each course should be integrated in the syllabus document.
- f. The pre-requisites (labs, ICT equipment) for implementing B.Ed curriculum should be identified to compliance with the NCTE norms.

### Agenda 2. To present and discuss the newly designed syllabus for M.Ed programme:

The syllabus for M.Ed (Annexure III) was presented by Dr. Nishaben Prajapati. After a thorough discussion M.Ed Programme structure was finalized with the following modifications suggested by the experts:

- a. The courses offered in M.Ed Programme should be re-looked in the context of NEP 2020 and focused on skill and technology oriented aspects.
- b. Research methodology papers should be offered in 2 semesters not in 3 semesters.
- c. Change the terminology for papers "Dissertation 1", "Dissertation 2" and "Tool Development".
- d. Do not mention the private software or applications name in the syllabus.
- Courses for the M.Ed Programme were suggested to include under the following categories:
  - Core Courses
  - Specialised Minor Courses
  - Skill Enhancement Courses
- f. Following new papers were suggested to include in the syllabus:
  - Core courses: Technology enabled education
  - Specialised courses: Guidance & Counselling, Inclusive Education, School · management and Administration,
  - Skill development courses: Entrepreneurship education, Open and digital Education, 21st century skills, Wellness Management, AI communication

### **Major Action Points:**

- 1. Revised B.ED syllabus incorporating all the suggestions should be submitted by 25th June to
- 2. Syllabus of M.Ed Programme should be restructured and revised. A revised draft of the M.Ed syllabus should be submitted by 25th June to BOS members.
- 3. Course code for all the courses of M.ED Pragramme should be formed according to the University norms and mentioned in the syllabus document.

The meeting was concluded with vote of thanks by Dr. Lingamurthy, Assistant Professor and Coordinator, School of Education and Training acknowledging the inputs given by all the faculties present in the meeting.
