Resolved that National Skill Qualification Framework (NSQF) of 05th, 06th and 7th Level of Skill Qualifications Packs designed and offered by Tourism and Hospitality Skill Council (THSC) may be adopted and applied in the respective courses where specific skills are required for the students to be equipped with the skills in the concerned areas: Tour Manager, Team leader (Travel), Meeting, Conference and Event Planner, Travel Consultant, Transport Duty Manager

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Agenda Item-3

University-Industry Interface Event, Study Tour, Destination Visit and Preparation for Final Placement and any other extra co-curricular activities such as World Tourism Day, World Heritage Day and India Tourism Day.

The BoS has resolved to recommend to conduct an annual event in collaboration with industry partners as a part of University-Industry Interface Event. Further the Board has also recommended the expenditure of this event along with Study Tour, Destination Visit and Preparation for Final Placement and any other extra co-curricular activities such as World Tourism Day, World Heritage Day and India Tourism Day may be met from Academic Development Fund to be created separately from the contributions made by the students during the admission. The University will transfer the amount paid under this head to the HoD Account for organization of these events. It is recommended to collect Rs. 10,000/- each at the time of the admission to the First Semester and Third Semester. The above said contributions shall be over and above the university admission and other fees.

The board strongly recommends for procurement of Amadeus Training software to train the students and the training must be imparted in the Dedicated Computer Lab for the Department. And all books mentioned in the reference of the courses must be procured on a priority basis.

The Board strongly recommends to the University for establishment of Placement Cell and Learning-cum-Leadership Cell to train and place the students. The cost of establishment of these two cells may be met by the University.


