Consideration of the change in the nomenclature of the M.Sc. programme

The Chairman informed that the Department offers two year M.Sc. programme in Applied Geology and Geo-informatics. This is apart from the five year integrated B.Sc. / M.Sc. programme offered as IMSc. Geology. The BoS after thorough discussion and review of the course curriculum, unanimously recommended to rename the MSc (Applied Geology and Geoinformatics) as MSc (Applied Geology) from next academic year.

It was also resolved that another meeting of BoS may be convened shortly to finalize the syllabus. This could be done after a draft syllabus is proposed through circulation by inputs from the other members.

Item No. 3 Approval of the syllabus for the taught course component for Ph.D.

In accordance with the latest UGC Regulations, course work is mandatory for the first semester of the Ph.D. programme. Accordingly, revised syllabus for the taught component of the course work for PhD is approved. While two of these papers are offered as per the UGC regulations (Research Methodology theory and a paper on Quantitative Methods), a third optional paper has to be offered based on specialization of faculty concerned.
