Thanks for accepting our invitation and being part of our department Program. The agenda of the BoS meeting is as following;

- I. The new papers/courses introduced for the Post Graduation and PhD coursework to be approved.
- II. The following papers introduced after the previous BoS are to be ratified. See Table 2.
- III. Review of Reorganization of the papers/ course related to Foundation Course and Discipline Specific Electives across the MA. semesters.
- IV. We are currently offering “MA in History” program, which is proposed to be renamed/reconstituted as “MA in History and Archaeology”.
- V. The name of the “Department of History” is proposed to be reconstituted as “Department of History and Archaeology”.

**Discussion/ Resolutions/ Minuets conducted on February 23-24 2021**

- I. The new courses introduced with full syllabus were taken into the discussion and all the experts reviewed the content and approved for the introduction of the same, as per the Table 1 and Table 3.
- II. The papers which were introduced and taught after earlier BoS in 2016 were taken for discussion and were ratified as per the Table 1, 2 and 3.
- III. Following the expert review of the revised syllabus, new courses and ratified courses; they are reorganized/mapped into semester wise distribution as per Table 3.
- IV. The discussion was placed to reconstitute “MA in History” programme into “MA in History and Archaeology” programme. The experts in view of employability of the graduates did not recommend this change with name of the programme.
- V. The BoS has shown their consent for reconstituting/ renaming the ‘Department of History’ as ‘Department of History and Archaeology’.
- VI. For the 2020-2022 batch, following changes were introduced

- In semester I, Contemporary Social Issues was made a 4 credit single course, in lieu of English language (2 credits) and Contemporary Social Issues Part I (2 credits).
- In Semester II- Discipline Specific Electives are included, in which the students will choose 2 out of 3 DSE options in lieu of Contemporary Social Issues Part II
