## INSTRUCTIONS TO M.Phil/Ph.D ASPIRANTS

All those candidates who have appeared for CUCET 2019 entrance and secured minimum prescribed marks (i.e., 50% in case of GM and 45% in case of OBC, SC, ST) are eligible for attending the personal interaction scheduled on 1& 2 July ,2019.

All qualified candidates of JRF/NET/SLET (Karnataka)/ M.Phil. and applied for CUCET 2019 can attend the personal interaction on 1 & 2 July, 2019.

The relative merit shall be decided based on CUCET marks (70% and interview/Viva-Voce 30%) as per UGC (Minimum Standards and procedure for the award of M Phil/Ph.D Degrees – 2<sup>nd</sup> Amendment) Regulations, 2018 dated 16/10/2018.

For Eligibility Criteria and Intake please refer Prospectus 2019.

Candidates called for personal interaction are hereby informed to be present at the respective Department at Central University of Karnataka, Kadaganchi, Aland Road, Kalaburagi-585367 at 10.00am on 01 July 2019 for personal interaction. The interaction may be extended to the next day, if required.

The candidates called for personal interaction are informed to submit a three to five pages well written analytical synopsis (5 sets) on the topic of their interest to present at the personal interaction. The candidates who fail to bring synopsis will not be allowed to attend the personal interaction.

The selection list will be announced on 02 July 2019 (after 6.00pm), and the candidates can pay fees on or before 03 July 2019. Candidates have to bring necessary certificates in original such as PG./ M.Phil Marks cards, NET/SLET Certificate, Category certificate and requisite fees to complete the admission formalities if selected.

In case of seats are vacant in respective stream of admission of Ph.D programme, vacant seats are interchangeable from CUCET quota to UGC-NET, etc., quota or vice-versa.

Candidate is not eligible if he/she has already registered for PhD programme in any University/ institution.

All qualified candidates may attend the interaction on 01 July, 2019 for M.Phil programme. Candidates will be admitted based on merit by following reservation policy.

The university reserves the right not to offer programme/s in any particular discipline due to administrative reasons or if the response to the programme is not adequate. The decision of the university will be final in this regard.
