FROM THE VICE CHANCELLOR

I have great pleasure in presenting the activities of Central University of Karnataka (CUK) through this Annual report for the period April 2012 to March 2013 with its commitment to become a University of Excellence at National and Global levels in the years to come. I took over the reins of the university as Vice Chancellor in Jan.2013 and initiated several steps to take CUK on the chosen path to achieve excellence. We want CUK to be distinct different and better. Our goal is to shape it to be a premiere National University with international recognition but addressing local issues.



The university is offering courses in English, Kannada, Hindi, Economics, commerce, Business Studies, History, Psychology, Social works, Geology, Geography, Physics, Mathematics and Computer Science. Our goal is make CUK a research and innovation university with mostly programs in dual degree (Bachelors and Masters) and stand alone Masters apart from PhD. India is fast emerging as a global hub of skilled and trained manpower. The CUK keenly identifies with these thoughts in its academic endeavours both in terms of the content and quality of teaching. This year the university has added two new unique courses first of its kind in India, the Dual Degree in Engineering and General Sciences keeping with the philosophy of achieving and maintaining the highest levels of academic excellence. The university has created a virtual class room facility with state of art multimedia equipment to conduct its online virtual classes from Bangalore. Community college schemes were taken up seriously by the university and from this year the courses in Aviation and Health Assistant under community college were introduced. 53 teaching faculty and around 40 non-teaching staff forming the CUK family strive to bring academic excellence to our university.

MoUs with PDA Engineering College, Karnataka German Technical Training Institute (KGTTI) were signed to harness and exchange the facilities between institutions.

The construction on the campus is going on in a big way and the university functioning from its temporary location at Gulbarga University campus is expected to move to its new campus by November, 2013. The campus is designed to be of world class and eco-friendly built on green campus concept. The campus is planned to be self-sustaining on energy and water resources. The entire campus had very little vegetation cover and hence massive greening is planned starting from planting 10,000 saplings with the help of forest department.

We had various distinguished invitees, dignitaries and experts to our campus to plan and develop a vibrant campus. Annual sports and cultural event ANKUR was celebrated with fervour wherein the CUK community has gained a new impetus and passion.

The students of CUK have participated in various interdisciplinary, cultural, sports and academic competitions at National level and have won many prizes. We hope that our efforts and initiatives will help the student community to shape their bright career towards greater heights.

This report reflects only the initial steps of a long journey so that this four year old university will take right path towards excellence mandated by our parliament.

ABOUT THE UNIVERSITY

The Central University of Karnataka is one of the new 16 central universities established in 2009 by an act of Parliament. The University is functioning from its temporary campus at Gulbarga University. The core activities of the university are learning, teaching and research with an aspiration to excel in undergraduate and postgraduate education and research. This year CUK continued a steady trend towards providing opportunities for students from many backgrounds across the country. The work on the CUK Campus at Kadaganchi is moving on a brisk pace and by all possibility it is expected to shift to its main campus by November 2013. The University's sustainability commitment was also met across campus through the work on water and energy management. The university is offering courses in English, Kannada, Hindi, Economics, commerce, Business Studies, History, Psychology, Social works, Geology, Geography, Physics, Mathematics and Computer Science leading to UG, PG and PhD degrees.

- The CUK has 1 GBPS leased internet connection provided under the National Mission on Education through Information and Communication Technology (NMEICT). Wi-fi facility is available to all the students and faculty.

The School of Undergraduate Studies coordinates with other Schools and Departments to provide a holistic undergraduate experience. It draws upon the academic resources of other schools to offer year integrated and flexible learning programmes leading to the award of BA (Hons) and MA Degree with exit option after the three years with award of BA (Hons) degree in History, Economics, Geography, Psychology and English subjects. Apart from this, the School also offers three year stand-alone BBA programme.

The undergraduate programmes are patterned to provide a holistic undergraduate experience which includes the Foundation Course (FC) and the Social Orientation Course (SoC).

CENTRE FOR CLASSICAL KANNADA

The Govt. of India declared Kannada as a classical languages (vide Ministry of culture Notification No.2-16/2004-Academis dated October 31, 2008). As a consequence, the MHRD asked the University Grants Commission to take follow up action. The UGC set up a Committee to look in to the modalities for establishment of the Centres of Classical Languages. The committee suggested that instead of professional chairs Centres of Classical languages be established in the select Central Universities. In pursuance of this decision at the Central University of Karnataka, the Centre for Classical Language-Kannada is setup. The work of the Centre is visualised as on-going process. Initially the Centre is established for five years and further continuity depends upon the success of the model process. The Centre shall not act in isolation with the other Indian Classical Languages. The Centre shall draw human resources from within and even outside the education system by interacting with the Pandits / Scholars who are well versed with the classical languages but are not necessarily a part of mainstream education system.

On March 15, 2011 the University Grants Commission approved setting up of the Centre for Classical Kannada at the Central University of Karnataka, Gulbarga. On April 11, 2011 the MHRD communicated the assent of the Visitor for Statute of Establishment of the Centre.

Main Thrust Areas

Linguistics, Epigraphy, Manuscriptology, History of Kannada and Karnataka, Religion Studies, Shastra Granthas, Classical Literature and Comparative Literature and Translation of Kannada Classical Texts.

Activities of the Centre

Advisory Committee Meeting

The **first Advisory Committee Meeting** of the Centre for Classical Kannada was held at NAAC, Bangalore on **June 10, 2012** from 10.30 am to 12.30 pm.

The following are the recommendations of the Advisory Committee Meeting.

a. The Road Map (and the presentation) was discussed and approved with the following amendment: In the document wherever 'oral epics' is mentioned, it will be amended to include "folklore as relevant to Classical Kannada studies".

b. It was decided to prioritize the proposals. Immediately the conduct of the short term and long term courses shall commence as proposed.

c. The work on the Compendium of Classical Kannada which is going to become part of the course materials may also commence.

d. Some of the initial tasks of the proposed work relating to concordance could be taken up with the help of scholars who have expertise. Priority among them is *Kavirajamarga* and *Chvundarayapurana/ Vaddaradhane*. After the ground work is completed, the computer generation of the concordance shall be done by the Centre.

e. Editing of unedited *shaastragranthas* also could be taken up on similar lines.

f. The work that has already been undertaken by the Manuscript Mission of India, Delhi relating to Classical Kannada manuscripts will be looked into.

g. Proposals shall be prepared and sent to the funding bodies for the creation of corpus of the inscriptions. Before doing so what has already been done by ICHR, Bangalore, Delhi etc., regarding digitization of the Classical Kannada inscriptions shall be looked into and work shall be undertaken in such a way that there is no duplication of work.

h. Efforts shall be made to fill up the remaining positions academic and administrative/technical sanctioned by the UGC for the Centre.

i. As and when the selected persons join they shall assist in the projects from the approved Road Map.

j. The time gap that is between the sanction of the Centre and commencement of work should be bridged and sanctioned funds utilized judiciously.

Workshop on *Chansshastra*

The workshop on *Chandasshastra* was conducted at CUK from **Nov 19 to 24, 2012**: On Nov 19, 2012 Prof.T.V.Venkatachalashastry the doyen of *chandasshastra* in Kannada inaugurated the workshop. Prof.Nagaraju, the Dean of SHL and Prof.ShivagangaRumma , VC i/c and all faculty of the workshop were present. Along with the participants of the workshop, the postgraduate students and Ph D students of the Department of Kannada too attended the function. The short inaugural was followed by an extensive overview of the *Chhandsshastra* in Kannada was provided by Prof. Venkatachalashastry with illustrations. Thus ended the learning in the forenoon of the first day. Prof. NarayanaPrasad, Head (Retired), Department of Kannada, Osmania University, Hyderabad who worked under Prof. T. V. Venkatachalashastry for Ph D was involved in the discussion. And at our request he covered the areas of *Chandasshastra* that were not covered in the forenoon session.

Though the theme was *Chandasshastra*, since it is very essential for the participants not to think of *Chandasshastra* as an autonomous entity, other essential features of classical Kannada too were covered. The following are the brief themes covered by each of the faculty of the workshop.

Prof.ShivagangaRumma: *Chandasshastra in its totality including aadhunikachandassu*. 2. Dr.BasavarajDonoor: *Translating Classical Kannada texts with examples from vacana literature*. 3. Dr.VikramVisaji: *Praaciina kannada pampare* 4. Dr.RajannaThaggi: *Kannada shaasanashastra an overview*. 5. Dr. Appagere Somashekhar: *Janapadamahaakaayagalu mattu avugala lakshanagalu*. 6. Dr. Basavaraj Kodaganti: *Vibhaktipratyayagalu part in the Kannada bhaashaavinyasa*. 7. Prof. B Mallikarjun: *Kannada bhaasheya praaciinate and other aspects of Kannada bhaashaavinyasa*.

The programme ended November 24, 2012 with a short valedictory address by Prof.S.Chandrashekhar the Vice Chancellor i/c of CUK. He also distributed the certificates to the participants. The Dean of SHL and all the faculty of the workshop were present.

Workshop on *Shaasanashastra*

Workshop on *shaasanashastra* at CUK from **March 11 to 16, 2013**. Out of the applications received 21 persons were selected keeping in mind the number of participants who can be accommodated in the space available for sitting. Out of them, 19 persons registered and participated in the programme.

On March 11, 2013 Prof.S.Sheshashastry Retired Professor, the doyen of *shaasanashastra* inaugurated the workshop. Prof.Prof.Shivaganga Rumma Head of the Department of Kannada chaired the inaugural session and all faculty of the workshop were present. Along with the participants of the workshop, the post graduate students and Ph D students of the Department of Kannada too attended the function. The short inaugural was followed by key note address by Prof.Sheshashastry. He provided background of the inscription studies undertaken in Karnataka. With this the session of the forenoon of the first day concluded.

Though the theme was *Shaasanashastra*, since it is very essential for the participants not to think of *shaasanashastra* as an autonomous entity, other essential features of Classical Kannada too were covered. Major theme of the workshop was taught by Prof.Shesha Shastry and Dr.Rajanna Thaggi. The following are the brief themes covered by each of the faculty member of the workshop.

Prof.ShivagangaRumma: *chandasshastra*

Dr.Basavaraj Donoor: Translating Classical Kannada texts with examples from *vacana* literature.

Dr.VikramVisagi: *praaciinakannadaparnpare*

Dr.Appagere Somashekhar: *janapadamahaakaayaga Lumattuavuga LalakshaNagaLu.*

Dr. BasavarajKodaganti: *vibhaktipratyayagaLupart in the Kannada bhaashaa Vinyaasa and Kannada samshoodhane*

Prof. B Mallikarjun: *Kannada bhaasheyapraaciinate* and other aspects of *Kannada bhaashaavinyaasa*.

On the final day on March 16, 2013, four of the participants made presentations of their analysis of some of the inscriptions. This was not part of the workshop but was included at the request of the participants. This went on well. These presentations were commented upon by the participants and the faculty.

The participants were given feedback form to provide feedback of the course. The following is the summary of the same. Out of 19 participants, 10 had started to work on inscriptions before their arrival; 8 were the beginners intending to take up work on inscriptions and one of the 19 had come for the course merely for the sake of interest; 10 of them opined that the core of instruction of the course was 'very useful', 9 persons opined 'useful'; 7 persons felt that the teaching of supplementary themes as 'very useful', 11 felt 'useful' and one person felt it of little use; communication methods used in the

course was felt 'very useful' by 11 persons, 'useful' by 9 persons and about the 6 day duration of the workshop was felt enough by 7 persons, 11 persons want the same to be increased and one person intended the same to be reduced.

The programme came to a close on March 16, 2013 with a short valedictory address by Prof. Sheshashastry he also distributed the certificates to the participants. Prof. Shivaganga Rumma Head of the Department of Kannada presided over the function.

Meetings on Integrated Language Sciences

Integrated Language Sciences- conducted one meeting (Feb 3, 2013) and participated in another meeting (March 22, 2013) held at Bangalore. This resulted in the CUK starting Ph D in linguistics and optional Linguistics at graduate level.



The Central Universities Act (2009) mandates the university to develop the School of Study system with a strong inter and multi-disciplinary approach. Classes for the Monsoon semester began on 1st August 2012.

The salient academic features of the University include:

The undergraduate programmes are patterned to provide a holistic undergraduate experience which includes the **Foundation course (FC)** and the **Social Orientation Course (SoC)**.

The Foundation course is designed to not only develop a student's understanding and grasp in his/her own subject of choice but also to enable them to develop capabilities of lateral thought, integrated understanding, holistic knowledge and a keen cognitive perception of their surroundings. The Social Orientation Course, which is compulsory for students of all undergraduate and post-graduate courses is planned to make the student into a responsible citizen wherein he/she will appreciate the country's working, laws, resources, culture and develop a spirit that is constructive, informed and positive.

Apart from the above components, the courses include core subjects, elective / allied subjects and language subjects which allow the student to choose and design his programme content.
