



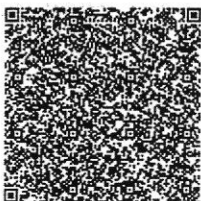

Memorandum of Understanding

This Memorandum of Understanding (hereafter referred to as 'MoU' signed on the 23rd day of June 2022 by & between the Central University of Karnataka (CUK) at Kalaburagi, Karnataka, India (hereafter referred to as CUK), as party one.

AND

Government Tool Room and Training Centre, Bengaluru (hereafter referred to as GTTC) as party two.

Whereas

Central University of Karnataka (CUK) was established by an Act of the Parliament (No.3 of 2009) at Kalaburagi, Karnataka. It is one of the 16 Central Universities newly established by the Government of India during the XI Plan Period to address the concerns of equity and access; by providing quality higher education for the people living in educationally under developed districts of the state. The CUK, with its territorial jurisdiction all over Karnataka started its academic and research activities, since its establishment in 2009.

The University campus is spread over 654 acres, near Kadaganchi, a village in the district of Kalaburagi, Karnataka. The main objective of this growing University is to integrate teaching, learning, training, research, innovation and skill development with an aspiration to excel in under graduate, post graduate and doctoral studies. The University offers programs in six major areas: Arts, Humanities, Social Sciences, Management, Sciences, and Engineering. The University is striving towards making the campus green, energy efficient and sustainable.

The University has designed the syllabus for all the programs as per the NEP-2020 / NSQF guide lines and created infrastructure to conduct academic and research activities as per the NEP / NSQF recommendations. The establishment to labs, installation of smart panels and construction of sophisticated instrumentation and incubation centers facilitate the teaching, learning and training process in the University.

- To provide avenues of higher education and research facilities.
- To disseminate and advance knowledge by providing instructional, skilling and research facilities to students.
- To collaborate with national and international universities and organizations, especially for undertaking vocational training and higher education.
- To formulate student-centric development models, publish reports and monographs and to organize conferences and seminars on issues relating to economical weaker section communities and provide inputs to policy matters in different spheres.
- To take appropriate measures for promoting innovations in teaching learning process in inter-disciplinary studies and research paying special attention to the improvement of social, educational and economic conditions and welfare of the scheduled tribes scheduled caste, OBC within the Union of India.

Whereas

Government Tool Room and Training Centre (GTTC) is an organization providing technical skill training in the areas of advanced technology to students, job seekers, school dropouts, and unemployed youth and industry personnel. It was established in 1972 at Bangalore by the Government of India and the Government of Karnataka with the assistance of DANIDA, Government of Denmark under the Bilateral Development Co-operation. Based on the excellent performance of GTTC Bangalore, the proactive Government of Karnataka felt the need for its expansion. Thus, GTTC started working with the assistance of DANIDA in 1992.

The Govt. of Karnataka has established thirty centers across the state to cater to the skill education needs of the youth. The centers are as follows:

Centre of Excellence:

Govt. of Karnataka established 15 Centers of Excellence (COE) in association with industry partners: Siemens, Dassault Systems, PTC, Autodesk at GTTC centers with an objective to act as a bridge between industries and institutions in skilling and up skilling areas.

The parties here by agree that:

1. Both the University and GTTC shall work towards strengthening vocational students in the state of Karnataka. One such way shall be through offering B.Voc programme in Tool Engineering, Electronics, Mechatronics, Precision Manufacturing, Industrial Robotics & Automation, Artificial Intelligence, Machine Learning, Industrial IOT etc. The collaborative scheme at the centers of GTTC and the degrees of all such programs shall be awarded by CUK.
- a) The titles of the programme to be offered at the centres of GTTC shall be as under:
 - i. B.Voc in Tool Engineering (Mechanical Engineering)
 - ii. B.Voc in Electronics
 - iii. B.Voc in Mechatronics
 - iv. B.Voc in Computer Integrated Manufacturing (Mechanical Engineering).
 - v. B.Voc in Industrial Robotics & Automation
 - vi. B.Voc in Aerospace Engineering (Precision Manufacturing in Aerospace Sector)
 - vii. B.Voc in Data Science
 - viii. B. Voc in Product Design and Development.
 - ix. B. Voc in Electrical Engineering
 - x. B. Voc in Technical Trainers Training

- d) All correspondence are to be made through the Registrar of CUK
- e) There shall be a Joint Coordination Committee (here after referred to as JCC) consisting



of six members, Registrar, Director of Academics and Dean, School of Engineering from CUK and three nominees from GTTC. The Director of GTTC shall be the Chair person of the Committee and Director of Academics of CUK will be the Co-chair person. Travelling allowance, accommodation and sitting charges of the members attending JCC meetings will be borne by GTTC.

- f) The JCC would monitor the academic activities of the programs offered in GTTC centers in accordance with the statutory framework of CUK and GTTC. The JCC shall meet minimum twice a year or whenever it is required. The Chairman of JCC shall convene the meetings. The JCC shall consider and decide the policy matters concerning academic programs under the collaborative scheme and all the norms including their recommendations of BoS shall be placed before JCC for its approval.
- g) The Board of Studies (BoS) shall be constituted as per the CUK Ordinance with two members from GTTC. The meetings of Board of Studies shall be convened periodically to discuss the academic programs. The Chairman of BoS shall convene the meetings. The Dean, School of Engineering of CUK shall be the Chairman of the BoS. Travelling allowance, accommodation and sitting charges of the members attending BoS meetings will be borne by GTTC. The Board of Studies formulates scheme of instruction, examination and evaluation as specified by UGC guidelines for B.Voc program.
- h) GTTC shall submit the intake for each B.Voc program in each center every year to CUK for its approval after the approval of the JCC.
- i) GTTC shall prepare prospectus covering conduct of entrance exam, fee structure, and syllabus and submit the same to CUK for its approval after the approval of the JCC.
- j) GTTC shall set question papers, conduct entrance examination in any number of centers at its own cost under the supervision of COE of CUK. CUK may depute its observers at examination centres and travelling allowance, accommodation and sitting charges of the observers attending exam centers shall be borne by GTTC.
- k) Travelling allowances, hospitality and honorarium / sitting charges for the nominated members of the CUK attending any other academic and exam related meetings at GTTC or at any other place shall be borne by GTTC as per their eligibility.
- l) The admission process as adopted by the GTTC for programs shall be considered for approval of the Competent Authority of CUK. The entrance examination shall be conducted by CUK in consultation with GTTC in the centres identified by GTTC and the expenses of which shall be borne by GTTC. Student selection is based on merit cum roster system.
- m) The students who become eligible for admission to B.Voc programs after clearing the entrance examination shall be admitted to various GTTC centers. CUK shall allot enrolment numbers to the admitted students.

- n) GTTC shall utilize and share the infrastructure facilities of GTTC centres for its B.Voc program.
- o) Industry Institute Interactions with CUK students for knowledge enhancing and placements assistance.
- p) Both the parties agree to facilitate any academic or professional enhancing tie-ups of GTTC with the foreign institutions or universities for joint academic endeavors.
- q) Library and laboratory facilities of CUK and GTTC shall be availed by the students, scholars and faculty of both the institutions.
- d) GTTC shall pay Rs.5000 per student per semester to CUK towards registration, enrolment, and other administrative charges for the B.Voc program.
- e) GTTC shall conduct the semester-end exams as per the CUK exam guidelines. The CUK shall send the University Observers to GTTC exam centers if necessary.
- f) GTTC shall conduct an evaluation as per the CUK guidelines.
- g) The MoU shall remain valid for an initial period of 10 years and may be renewed further on terms and conditions mutually agreed upon by both the parties in writing.
- h) This MoU may be terminated by either party on an advance notice of three months. However, if this MoU is terminated for what so ever reason, the responsibilities of each party shall continue to exist till the completion of the programs to which the students are admitted on or before the date of the notice of termination.
- i) If disputes or difference so for any kind what so ever arising between the parties in connection with or arising out of this MoU, the parties shall resolve them with in a period of two months in the first instance by mutual discussion.
- j) If any doubt arising as to the interpretation of the provisions of this MoU or as to matters not provided there in, the parties to this MoU shall consult each other on each instance and resolve such doubts in good faith.
- k) All alterations or amendments to this MoU shall be mutually discussed and agreed in writing. No amendment for change here of shall be effective or binding on the parties here to unless set in writing and executed by the respective duly authorized representative so for each of the parties here to.

- l) However, in case of any dispute, arbitrator be appointed with mutual consent of both the parties. Decision of the arbitrator or would be final and binding on both the parties.
- m) The copy rights of course materials developed by GTTC shall rest solely with GTTC. And those developed by CUK shall rest with CUK. However, both the parties shall be free to utilize the course material of either party with prior approval from the other party. Due acknowledgement will be given to the developer of such course material.
- n) All notices, requests or other communications here under shall be sent in writing and addressed to the Registrar/Controller of Examination/ Director (Admissions)/ Director, Academics of CUK or Director of GTTC, as the case may be.
- o) That GTTC shall prepare the examination time schedule and list of question paper setters and evaluators in consultation with CUK and the final results of the examinations shall be declared by CUK.
- p) That CUK will award the Degree and issue grade cards under its insignia to the successful students as per the existing nomenclature.
- q) The degrees of CUK shall be awarded to the eligible students at the CUK Convocation. The eligible students can apply for provisional degree certificates on payment of requisite fees at any time after the declaration of results of the qualifying examination.
- r) Plagiarism formalities will be strictly followed and it will be the sole responsibility of the concerned center of GTTC.
- y) That all notices, requests or other communication hereunder shall be sent in writing and addressed to the Registrar/Controller of Examinations/Director (admission)- CUK or Director, GTTC as the case may be.

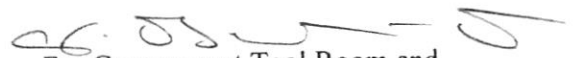
