Since its inception, it has encouraged, motivated, and enlightened approximately 2,00,000 students across Karnataka.

Campus 2 Community by Yuvaka Sangha is a youth platform that engages college students in real-time grassroots community work. Under **Project Campus 2 Community Fellowship**, offering life skills and **21st-century skills** training through workshops. Volunteers will then implement these skills in hands-on community engagement projects focused on themes such as environment, tech awareness, and career guidance, with an emphasis on behavioral change and project-based learning.

The Campus 2 Community Fellowship provides **100 hours of community service**, aligning with Students **"Community Service Activities"**. Through structured volunteering and training, students gain meaningful learning experiences while fulfilling Community experiential learning criteria.

We plan to initiate a three-month volunteering phase for each batch, involving 50 volunteers per phase, with the goal of engaging 150 students from the institution between August 2025 and July 2026. This program aims to enhance students' personalities and equip them with essential life skills that complement academic knowledge. Importantly, this initiative will not affect students' academic events, as per Community guidelines.

The program will feature interactive workshops, physical and mental activities, group discussions, and guest speakers from various fields, all led by experienced trainers and facilitators. By participating, students will develop a strong skill set for solving challenges.

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MoU)

BETWEEN

YUVAKA SANGHA , BENGALURU

AND

CUK KARNATAKA, KALABURGI

Memorandum of Understanding (MoU)

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is made and entered into by and between

Yuvaka Sangha, a registered Non-Governmental Organization, having its Registered Office at Yuvapatha. 4, 31st Cross, 11th Main Rd, 4th Block, Jayanagar, Bengaluru, Karnataka 560011 and dedicated to Sustainable Community Development,

and

CUK Karnataka Kalaburgi, a Central Government University, Established by an Act of the Parliament in 2009, having its Campus at Kadaganchi, Aland Road, Kalaburagi Dist. - 585 367, to collaborate under the **Campus 2 Community Initiative**, as part of the **Campus 2 Community Fellowship**.

Purpose:

The purpose of this MoU is to outline a Partnership that promotes student involvement in mentioned IQAC Criteria 5: Student Support and Progression (5.1.3) / AICTE Activity Point Programme through Campus 2 Community-designed Social Initiatives and C2C-based Community Needs.

Scope and Program Framework:

As part of this module of the Project, the Parties have agreed to commence a structured **3-month Volunteering Program** for **50 Student-volunteers per batch**, targeting a total of **150 students [3 Batches]** from the Institution for the Academic Year Aug 2025 to July 2026.

The initiative includes:

1. **Student Volunteering:** Students will contribute to real-world issues through service in community-based projects.
2. **Training & Orientation:** Yuvaka Sangha will provide pre-engagement training, orientation sessions, and skill-building workshops.
3. **Community Immersion:** Selected students will participate in hands-on learning through community immersion, gaining transformative educational experiences
4. **21st Century Skills Set Training:** Developing essential skills for success in today's fast-paced, technology-driven world. These skills enable individuals to adapt, innovate, and thrive in personal and professional settings.

Roles and Responsibilities:

The Parties mutually agree their respective Roles and Responsibilities under this MOU shall be as under

Yuvaka Sangha:

- Facilitate Volunteer Placement and Support Community Projects.
- Deliver Training, Mentorship, and Regular Guidance to Student Volunteers.
- One [1] Full Time College Coordinator will be assigned to the Institution. He /She will visit and stay at Campus on Alternative Days for smooth Project-implementation.
- Campus 2 Community will track the Hours spent by each Student Volunteer in the Community

CUK Karnataka, Kalaburgi:

- Identify, Nominate and Encourage Student Volunteers for each Batch
- Integrate the Initiatives into Institutional Calendars and Academic Structure where

applicable.

- Collaborate in the Feedback and Review Mechanisms to ensure Program-effectiveness.
- The Institution will extend necessary support to the assigned Yuvaka Sangha Coordinator, including identifying Seating Space on Campus, Access to Internet access and an ID Card.
- Provide required support from the Institution in terms of access to requisite Infrastructure and Training Materials for the Engagement, with prior Approval.

Term:

This MoU is effective from **August, 2025** to **July, 2026** and shall expire unless renewed with such terms and conditions as may be mutually agreed to then.

Termination:

Either Party may terminate this MoU by providing a 30-day written notice to the Other Party. This collaboration signifies a shared commitment to creating meaningful Social Impact while nurturing Student Leadership and Civic Engagement.

Communication:

Monthly Meetings and Meetings before any Event shall be informed by the Coordinator of C2C. The Meetings shall also review the Progress of the Project and also discuss Plans for Effective Development.
