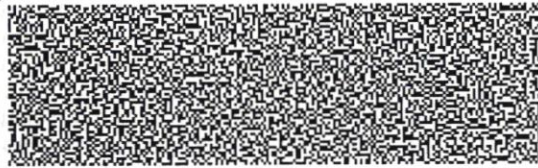

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**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN
 CENTRAL UNIVERSITY OF KARNATAKA (CUK) AND
 PRAGNA MICRO DESIGNS, BANGALORE**

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is made and entered into on this 15th day of 05 2025, by and between **Central University of Karnataka (CUK)**, located at Kalaburagi, India, hereinafter referred to as "First Party," and **Pragna Micro Designs**, located at Bangalore, India, hereinafter referred to as "Second Party," collectively referred to as "the Parties."

1. Preamble

WHEREAS, the First Party is a premier institution of higher education engaged in teaching, research, and training;

AND WHEREAS, the Second Party is an industry-leading organization specializing in research, technology development, and training initiatives;

AND WHEREAS, both Parties recognize the mutual benefits of collaborating in the fields of research, skill development, and knowledge sharing;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual benefits and interests, the Parties hereby agree as follows:

2. Objective

The primary objective of this MoU is to establish a collaborative framework for research and training between the Parties, with the aim to:

a. Facilitate joint research activities and promote interdisciplinary collaboration. b. Exchange knowledge, resources, and expertise to enhance research outcomes. c. Provide structured training opportunities for researchers, faculty members, and students to develop their skills and knowledge. d. Explore and pursue joint funding opportunities to support collaborative research projects. e. Promote the dissemination of research findings through publications, conferences, patents, and other platforms.

3. Scope of Collaboration

The scope of this collaboration shall include, but not be limited to:

a. **Research Collaboration:** Identifying and executing research projects of mutual interest, including the preparation of joint research proposals, exchange of data and research facilities, and collaborative publication efforts. b. **Training, Seminars, and Workshops:** Organizing workshops, short-term courses, faculty development programs, and technical training sessions for knowledge and skill enhancement. c. **Internship and Industrial Exposure:** Providing internship and training opportunities for students and researchers to gain hands-on experience in real-world applications. d. **Exchange of Experts:** Facilitating the exchange of faculty, researchers, and students for joint projects, consultancy, and knowledge transfer initiatives. e. **Infrastructure and Resource Sharing:** Exploring opportunities for sharing research facilities, laboratory equipment, software tools, and databases to support collaborative projects. f. **Joint Funding and Grants:** Identifying potential sources of funding and applying for external grants to support joint research and academic activities.

4. Implementation Mechanism

To ensure the effective implementation of this MoU, the Parties agree to:

a. Appoint a **Coordination Committee** comprising representatives from both Parties to oversee and facilitate the activities under this MoU. b. Develop detailed action plans for specific projects and define roles and responsibilities. c. Conduct periodic meetings to evaluate progress and address challenges, if

any. d. Submit annual reports documenting the activities, achievements, and future plans under this MoU.

5. Confidentiality and Intellectual Property Rights (IPR)

a. Both Parties agree to maintain strict confidentiality concerning proprietary and sensitive information exchanged during the collaboration. b. Any intellectual property generated as a result of joint research shall be jointly owned, and the terms of commercialization and patent rights shall be mutually agreed upon before filing any patents or publications. c. Any publication or public disclosure of research findings shall require prior approval from both Parties.

6. Financial Arrangements

a. This MoU does not create any financial liability on either Party unless specific projects or initiatives requiring funding are mutually agreed upon in separate agreements. b. Any financial commitment shall be detailed in specific project agreements, funding applications, or sponsorship agreements.

7. Duration, Renewal, and Termination

a. This MoU shall be effective for a period of **three (3) years** from the date of signing unless extended by mutual written agreement. b. Either Party may terminate this MoU by giving **three (3) months' written notice** to the other Party, provided that such termination shall not affect ongoing projects unless otherwise agreed upon. c. The MoU may be renewed upon mutual consent based on a review of achievements and future collaboration prospects.

8. Dispute Resolution

In the event of any dispute arising out of or in connection with this MoU, the Parties shall resolve the matter amicably through mutual consultation. If the dispute remains unresolved, it shall be referred to arbitration in accordance with the **Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996**, and the venue for arbitration shall be **Bangalore, India**.

9. Amendments

This MoU may be amended, modified, or supplemented only by mutual written agreement signed by authorized representatives of both Parties.

10. Signatories

This Memorandum of Understanding is signed in duplicate, with each Party retaining one original copy for their records.
